
Health Science

Workers at the Mount Washington Observatory installed the new weather vane created by Andy Shaw's Advanced Manufacturing class. Initial reports from atop the rockpile indicate "that it is easier to de-ice than the old vane. Most likely due to the smooth surfaces compared to the nicked and scarred old one. It also seems to be more sensitive to direction changes, another plus. Our Meteorologists will be conducting longer term studies on this as this will be important to our dataset."
